ART ON THE CORNER is a unique outdoor sculpture exhibit that was one of the first in the country. Located in award-winning Downtown Grand Junction, the exhibit hosts a variety of artwork and introduces viewers to many artistic approaches and is free of charge. Founded in 1984 by area sculptors, the program now consists of almost 100 pieces of permanent and temporary artworks from artists around the nation.

The Art on the Corner (AOTC) Committee helps select pieces for the temporary collection every year. These pieces are for sale to the public and 25% of the sales help fund the future of the program.
